

STYLES DRAWS 4 TO 8 YEARS IN PERJURY TRIAL

**Ex-Queens G.O.P. Leader
Calm but Wife Cries
on Hearing Sentence.**

With his customary bravado and flashing smile missing, Harry J. Styles today was sentenced for perjury to from four to eight years in Sing Sing by Judge Frank F. Adel in Queens County Court after his counsel had pleaded for leniency on the ground that Styles had been affected by the "political hysteria" in Queens.

The convicted Jamaica real estate operator and former Ku-Klux **Klan** Kleagle, heard the sentence calmly, It was a subdued Styles, however, and even the colorful clothing he had worn during his trial had been replaced by a quiet blue suit, plain white shirt and black tie.

Wife in Tears.

Mrs. Styles, seated in the courtroom with her three children, had tears in her eyes, but otherwise heard the sentence as calmly as her husband.

The room was crowded and many of the known Queens Klansmen who had attended every session of the three-day trial that resulted in Styles' conviction on April 26, were back there today. They whispered together as sentence was pronounced and the impression was that they thought it stiff. Styles is one of them no longer, however, as a letter sent out by the Major Emmett D. Smith **Klan** about two months ago reported that he had been banished for some offense.
