1909 ALCO-6 BLACK BEAST RACER WILL BE FEATURED AT THE 2TH ANNUAL VANDERBILT AUTOCROSS AND CONCOURS DE PROVENANCE AT ROOSEVELT FIELD

The 1909 Alco-6 *Black Beast* Racer, the winner of the 1909 and 1910 Vanderbilt Cup Races and a participant in the first Indy 500 Race, will be featured at the 2nd Annual Vanderbilt Autocross and Concours de Provenance to be held on Sunday, July 26, 2009 from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM.
