

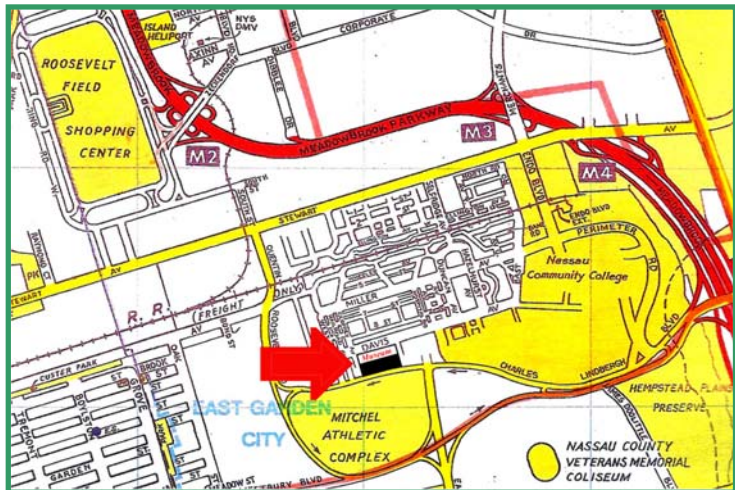

## **Towing Routes:**

### **From Southern New Jersey and West:**

*Cross the Verrazano Bridge and take the BQE/I-278 ± 17 miles. Crossing the Kosciusko Bridge, stay in right lane and exit right to the **Long Island Expressway / I-495 East***

### **From Northern New Jersey and Connecticut:**

*cross the Throgs Neck Bridge to Queens. Take the Clearview Expressway to the **Long Island Expressway / I-495 East***

*Once on I-495 take to **Exit 39 South (Glen Cove Rd).***

*Turn right (South) on Glen Cove Rd. ± 3 miles to Old Country Rd. (the first traffic signal after passing under a railroad trestle). Cross Old Country Road. Old Country Road becomes Clinton Road. Continue south on Clinton Rd. Turn left at Stewart Avenue eastbound. Take the first right south onto Quentin Roosevelt Blvd. curving east to a left northbound at Earle Ovington Blvd. and the next left westbound at Lindbergh Blvd. **Destination is the next right to Cradle of Aviation***

### **For passenger cars only:**

*Alternatively, you may take the Northern State Parkway East toward Hauppauge. Take exit 31A to merge with Meadowbrook State Pkwy South toward Jones Beach. Take exit M4W/Hempstead/Coliseum onto a long feeder road merging right onto Charles Lindbergh Blvd. Keep right to Museum Row. **The Cradle of Aviation will be on the right after the college parking lot.***
