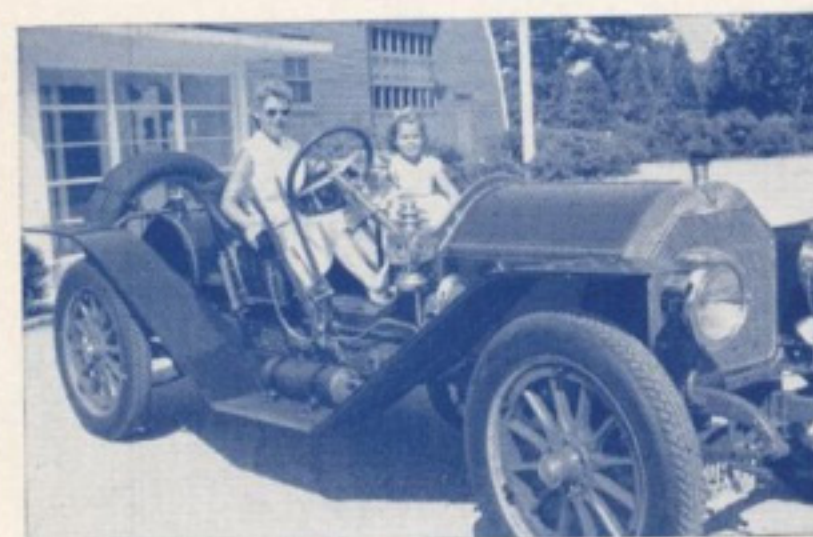
The Sandy Hollow Fire Department is the favorite of the children, containing several antique pieces of motorized apparatus, all in readiness to answer an alarm. The Museum also includes the only real collection of commercial vehicles on view anywhere. These early trucks range from light delivery vans to chain driven monsters capable of carrying many tons.



The Museum houses over one hundred antique cars and trucks in several buildings. These include examples of both famous and obscure makes of American and Foreign cars. They range from small machines of the late nineteenth century to powerful classic cars of more recent years. Steam and electric vehicles are shown as well as gasoline. Special collections of the Ford and Pierce-Arrow lines are featured, including every important model of each.

The workshop is constantly engaged in the restoration of more cars to a condition similar to new, without deviation from their original condition. This work can be seen from the floor.

A special section is devoted to a display of automotive art, both old and new as well as a fine selection of brass lamps, insignia, horns, hub caps and other old accessories. This section is shown in the photo to the left.

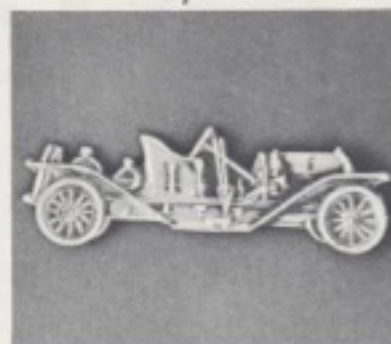


1910 SIMPLEX 50 H.P. SPEED CAR

The outstanding car on display is the famous Thomas Flyer which won the New York to Paris Race in 1908.

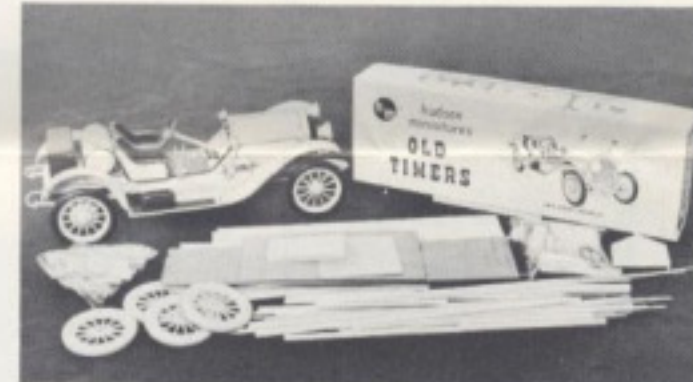

The parts department of the Museum fills orders for Model T Ford and other obsolete parts. Inquiries are invited.

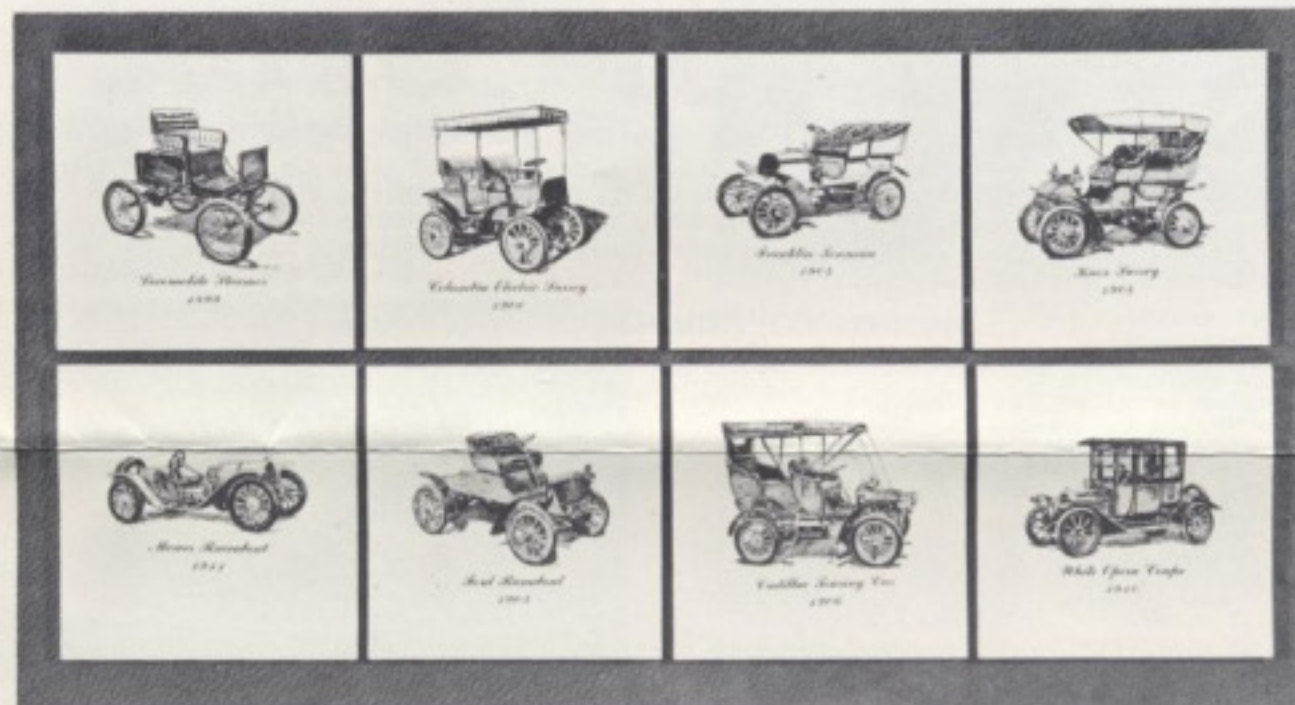
